HELP WANTED
JOB TITLE: President of the United States
JOB LOCATION: Washington, D.C.
SALARY: \$400,000 per year
QUALIFICATIONS: U.S. citizen, at least 35 years of age and a resident of the United States for 14 years before election
LENGTH OF TERM: Four years. The President may not serve more than two terms.
DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: Carries out the law, appoints Supreme Court Justices, commands the armed forces, conducts foreign affairs, signs bills into law or vetoes (rejects) them

2. List two skills that you think the President needs to do his job well. Explain your choices.

3. For how many years can the President serve? Why do you think there is a limit to how many terms a person can be President?

4. Do you think the law should be changed so that a person born outside the United States can become President? Why or why not?

5. What do you think is the President's most important responsibility?
